Born in 1963, in Haifa, Israel. Lives and works in Tel Aviv. BFA, photography, Bezalel Academy of Art and Design, Jerusalem, 1988 and Pratt Institute, New York, 1987; MFA, Université Paris 8, 1993. Awards and Prizes: Leon Constantiner Photography Award, Tel Aviv Museum of Art, 2002; Coreografo Elettronica Prize, Madre Museum of Contemporary Art, Naples, Italy, 2017.

Works in various mediums: emulsions on canvas, holograms, voile prints, glass prints, multichannel video installations. Yanor's "photographic choreography," creates an experimental hybrid space that places reality in a new and unexpected light, on the seam of photography, video, performance and technology.
